

Workshop Information Letter

Jerry Yarnell - "A Perfect Pair" - August 3 & 4, 2018

Class Date	Friday and Saturday, August 3rd and 4th, 2018
Location	The Art Center, 1810 S. Dumas Ave, Dumas, Texas
Class Time	Jerry begins his class at 9:00 a.m. The building will be open at 8:00 a.m. This give students a chance to purchase any needed supplies and get your palette set up. Lunch is 11:30 - 12:30 and class ends about 3:00 p.m. each day.
Art Supplies	A word of advice from Jerry: "Fine Art techniques require Fine Art Tools." Enclosed you will find a basic supply list. You are responsible for furnishing your own supplies - however - for your convenience - a full art supply store including brushes, paints, canvases, books and art supplies will be available. Tables, chairs, and easels are provided.
Using oil versus acrylics	The question comes up regularly. Jerry prefers working in acrylics; however, if you prefer working with oils, please use the water-miscible oils. Some of us are allergic to traditional oils. Oils take longer to dry and sometimes students feel a little rushed with the required drying time. When painting with oil, Jerry uses a product called Quick Dry (water-miscible) to speed the drying time as well as Linseed Oil (water-miscible) in the mixing. (To avoid confusion, we do not use Gesso with oil painting. Rather, we use Titanium White water-miscible.) If you are unable to fine these prior to your trip, Jerry will have these products available for purchase.
Transportation, Food & Lodging	Students are responsible for their own transportation, food and lodging. The Art Center does have a refrigerator and microwave if you would like to bring your lunch. We are enclosing a list of all of the accommodations in Dumas.
Class Payment	We do require a non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 to hold your place in class. This fee will be deducted from the total workshop tuition of \$225. Registered students who cancel at any time will not be refunded the registration fee. The balance of \$175 will be due two weeks before the first day of the workshop (July 20). Make checks out to The Art Center . If for any reason, The Art Center cancels the class, you will receive a full refund. For non-members, we do require a \$5.00/day building use fee. Membership can be purchased for \$15 annually.
